Revision The Regional Commissioner may on his own motion or on the application of any person call for and examine the records of any order passed by the Assistant Commissioner u/s 118 (2-B) against which no appeal lies or the records of any order passed or proceedings recorded by the Tahsildar, for the purpose of satisfying himself as to legality or propriety of such an order and may pass such an order as he thinks fit.
7	Karnataka Regulation of unauthorized construction in Urban Areas Act, 1991.	Sec.8A In respect of orders passed by the Competent Authority.	Revision The Regional Commissioner may on his own motion or on the application of any person call and examine the orders passed by the Competent Authority for the purpose of satisfying himself and may pass such orders as deemed fit.
8	The Karnataka irrigation Act, 1965.	Sec.66 In respect of any proceedings under the Act. by the Deputy Commissioner, Irrigation officer or any subordinate Officer.	Revision The Regional Commissioner may call or Examine the records or proceedings under the Act of the Deputy Commissioner/Irrigation officer/ any Officer subordinate to the Deputy Commissioner and may pass such other orders as he may deem Just.
